-Cut 2 contrasting and 1 batting or fusible batting

TIP : You could even use an orphan block

Lay batting on bottom (fusible is great)

Lay outside fabric face up

Lay inside fabric face down

Pin in center to hold while sewing

1 Sew 1/2" seam, leaving 1 1/2" opening to turn

2 Clip corners, turn, press

3 Free motion quilt, if desired

4 Topstitch 1/8"-1/4" around edge

5 Fold corners diagonally in half, measure desired amount from the corners. Draw a vertical line at the pin, from the top to the bottom of the tray. Sew on line.

NOTE : the longer the vertical, the higher the sides & the smaller the box will be.
