

KLEENEX POUCH (Anne Marcellis)

Outside: 5 ½" x 6 ½"

Inside: 5 ½" x 7 ½"

4 pins

Seam ripper

Travel kleenex

1. Place the fabrics right side together, and sew a ¼" seam down both shorter 5 ½" sides. The lining fabric is larger than the outside fabric so the pieces won't lay flat.



2. Turn right side out. Press so about ¼" of the lining fabric is showing on each end.



3. Fold the outside edges towards the center. You'll be looking at the lining fabric.



4. Stitch a seam along both short ends.

5. Turn right side out.



6. Slit the back of the travel Kleenex up the longer center with a seam ripper. Insert into pouch. Enjoy!
