

# HEXIE TRAY

1. Print several copies of 3" hexies onto freezer paper, run through Inkjet printer.
2. Cut freezer paper hexie on line.
3. Layer several Shape-flex and pin 1 hexie freezer paper. Cut out.
4. Cut 2 fabrics larger than the hexie pattern. Place right sides together.
5. Iron shiny side of freezer paper to back of these 2 hexie shapes.
6. Sew along the freezer paper edge, leaving a 2" opening for turning. Back stitch.
7. Sew the rest of the sides. Iron 1 shape-flex to the back of the outer piece.
8. Leaving paper on, trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each edge. *Note:* I cut  $\frac{3}{8}$ " along the opening edge.
9. Trim corners.
10. Peel off freezer paper. *Note:* This can be reused numerous times.
11. While inside out, press the opening seam allowances.
12. Turn right side out, using point turner. I used a little Elmer's glue to secure the opening closed.
13. Topstitch along 6 edges.
14. Fold the inside pointed edge to itself. Pin, mark  $\frac{1}{2}$ " in both directions
15. Sew on this line.
16. Fill with your items!
