

CUTTING PATTERN PIECES (continued)

Various fabrics (To make “modern” fabric) All tote bags.

18 scraps of solid and prints. Cut (1) each 22” x 3”. You will cut them later into widths 1 ¼”-3” wide.

White (for “modern” fabric creation)

Cut at least (6) strips 3” x 22” long. You will cut them later into widths 1 ¼”-3” wide.

(3) different dark green (for flower stems)

Cut (3): 1 ½” x 4”, 2” x 4”, 2 ½” x 4” **NOTE:** Cut on bias so they will bend easier.

(3) different medium green (for flower bases)

Cut (6) 8” squares (2 each of 3 different shades).

Black *Cut in order listed*

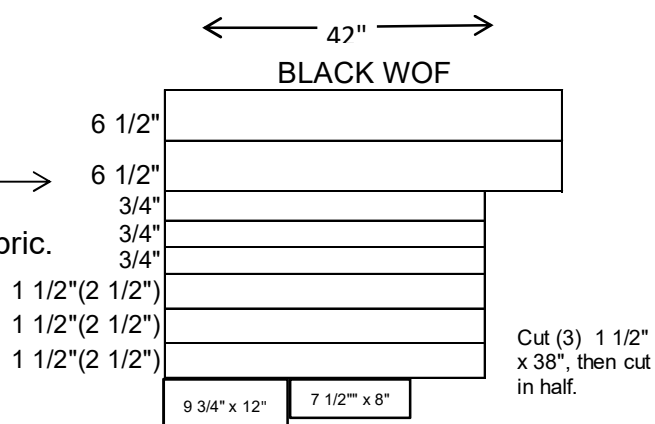
1-Cut (2) 6 ½” x WOF for handles.

2-Cut (22) ¾” x 13 ½” strips for constructing modern fabric.

3-Cut (3) 1 ½” [2 ½”] x 38” upper & lower bands.

4-Cut (1) 9 ¾” x 12” for outside pocket lining.

5-Cut (1) 7 ½” x 8” for outside back pocket lining.



PFF (WOF is based on 60” wide). *Cut in order listed.*

1-Cut (2) 6 ½” x WOF for handles.

2-Cut (1) 5 ½” x WOF for inside lining pocket.

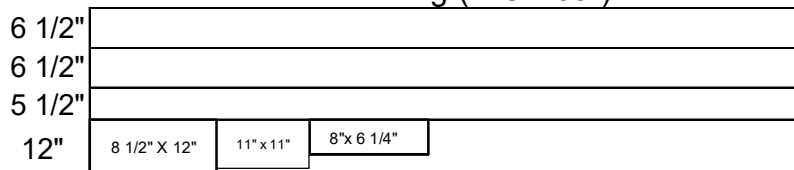
3-Cut (1) 8 ½” x 12” for front outside pocket.

4-Cut (1) 11” x 11” for front tab.

5-Cut (1) 6 ¼” x 8” for outside back pocket.

PFF cutting (WOF 60”)



Freezer paper (Both tote bags)

Cut (3) 8” squares for flower bases.

Cut (1) 11” square for button tab.

ByAnnie’s Soft and Stable *This comes 60” wide.*

Cut (2) 17 ½” x 19” [21” x 19”] for tote front and back.

NOTE: You may want to use a marker to mark the measurement before cutting.
